The Container Exhibit Space will be prominently displayed down the main Show Boulevards during all three days of the **2010 Yard, Garden & Patio Show** presented by Dennis' Seven Dees Landscaping & Garden Centers, Feb. 12 – 14. Retailers, designers, local personalities – anyone with a creative eye can participate.



Container space is only \$150 per 3.5 ft. x 3.5 ft. display space and containers will be judged for a 'Best in Show-Containers' award!

- Display platforms will be approximately 6" off the ground creating a mini stage for your entry.
- You may have multiple containers in your exhibit spaces.
- You may lease multiple, separate 3.5 ft. x 3.5 ft. container exhibit spaces.
- The location and final placement of containers on the show floor will be decided and managed by the YGP Show.
- Each exhibitor receives one exhibitor pass.
- Two 5.5 in. x 8 in. signs will be provided by the YGP Show to display the exhibitor's name and contact information on two sides of the display.
- Your container creations must follow these criteria:
 - Plant material or container cannot exceed the 3.5 ft. x 3 ft. display space.
 - Non-plant material cannot exceed 8 ft in height.
 - At least 50% of the container display contents must be green goods.

Participation rules:

- Container(s) must arrive at the Show by 4PM, Thursday Feb 11.
- Exhibitors must arrange for delivery and pickup of their containers.
- Electrical power is NOT available for any container display.
- Exhibitors are not allowed to 'man' their container in the exhibit space.
- No additional promotional materials are allowed in the display.
- It's optional for exhibitors to sell containers from the show floor, but sales transactions and container pick-up are the sole responsibility of the exhibitor.
